ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CALLERY, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING A PORTION OF STAPLES AVENUE AND ALL OF WASHINGTON STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF CALLERY.

Whereas, a portion of Staples Avenue and all of Washington Street in Callery Borough, Butler County, Pennsylvania, through inadvertence appear on the Borough Plan; and

Whereas, said streets were never adopted by Council as public streets, were never opened or worked upon by the Borough.

Be it ordained and enacted by Council of the Borough of Callery, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted with and by authority of the same.

SECTION 1. That Staples Avenue from the West line of the first alley West of Main Street westwardly to its termination be deleted from the Borough Plan, and is hereby vacated as a public street.

SECTION 2. That Washington Street from the South line of Church Street to the South line of Center Street be deleted from the Borough Plan, and is hereby vacated as a public street.


